SPECTATORS AGREEMENT AND CODE OF CONDUCT

As a spectator(s) I/We promise to remember the following and to adjust my/our Behavior to conform to these principals:

- I recognize and agree that our children have more of a need for an adult example of
 mature behavior than for witnessing inappropriate criticism of players, coaches, or
 referees;
- I agree that play within the Westside United F.C. should be a positive experience for the players, coaches, administrators, parents, and others. If my circumstances make my experiences, or that of my child's participation, less than positive, I understand my right and obligation is to remove myself and my child from the Club. I will not allow my circumstances to create a less than positive environment for other players, parents, referees, coaches, or administrators;
- 3) I agree to accept the decisions of the coaches, referees, and administrators with respect and good grace.
- I agree to be generous when our teams win, and graceful when our teams lose. The most important principals to promote through our participation in the Westside United F.C., and in competition with other Clubs, are good sportsmanship, good citizenship, and the development of quality soccer skills through good competition.
- 5) I agree to conduct myself with honor and dignity.
- 6) I agree not to engage in physical or verbal confrontations with spectators, officials, coaches, administrators, or other players.
- 7) I promise to never encourage, or accept someone else's encouragement of, the intentional injury, of any player.
- 8) I agree to support the coach, coaching staff, and Club administrators.
- 9) I agree to never confront a coach at, during, or immediately after a game, and recognize that if I have a question or concern that I may always contact him or her at a later time.
- 10) I agree that I will never bring or use alcohol at a game.
